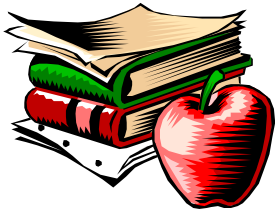

Why Does God Allow Sin? (By: Craig G.)

The following is reprinted from a previous issue a few years back:

I HEARD A GREAT SAYING IN A MESSAGE ONE TIME THAT GOES LIKE THIS, “YOU CAN CHOOSE THE SIN, BUT YOU CAN'T CHOOSE THE CONSEQUENCES.” ROMANS 6:23 SAYS THE WAGES OF SIN IS DEATH (HELL).

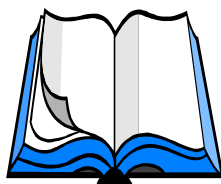

BUT, WHY DOES GOD ALLOW THE SIN? THE SIN WHICH TROUBLES AND DISCOURAGES MANY BELIEVERS. WHY DOES HE ALLOW SO MUCH SIN AND SUCH HORRIBLE SIN TO EXIST ALL AROUND US? WHY DO SOME OF THESE THINGS HAVE TO HAPPEN? IN THIS MESSAGE, I WANT TO COVER WHAT THE SPIRIT HAS BROUGHT TO MY HEART IN THIS MATTER.

FIRST LET ME TELL YOU THAT WE ARE DEFINITELY IN THE LAST DAYS BEFORE THE RETURN OF THE LORD. ANY BELIEVER CAN SEE THAT WITH HOW FAR THIS WORLD IN GENERAL HAS TURNED FROM THEIR CREATOR GOD AND TURNED TO A LIFE OF SIN. WHY DOES GOD ALLOW OR TOLERATE THIS? ALLOW MEANS TO PERMIT AND TOLERATE MEANS TO ALLOW TO BE OR TO BE DONE WITHOUT HINDRANCE. TO ENDURE OR RESIST THE ACTION OF. WHY DOES GOD ALLOW AND TOLERATE SIN?

A. HE IS A GRACIOUS GOD (Titus 2:11) (Grace is undeserved favor that God richly and abundantly bestows on both saved and lost)

1. We all deserve Hell (Rom. 3:12-18, 23)
2. He allows and tolerates it because of his grace (Rom. 6:1, 14-16)
3. He knows that we are going to sin because we are born in sin (Psalm 51:5)
4. He knows we have a free-will to commit sin...even after hearing the gospel (Heb. 10:26 – there will be more on this later on)
5. He is a long-suffering, compassionate and merciful God. God loves you and wants to save you from sin (Exo 34:6; Psalm 86:15; II Pet. 3:9). We don't deserve any of this amazing GRACE. We deserve HELL

B. IT IS OUR NATURE TO SIN (Satan is the father of sin – 1 John 3:8; John 8:44)

1. We are born with a sinful nature (Psalm 51:5; Rom. 5:12)
2. There is pleasure in sin (Satisfying the sensations) (John 8:34)

Kinds of: Physical (Eccl. 2:1-10); Worldly (Luke 8:14); Immoral (Titus 3:3 – the unsaved take pleasure in this immorality) (tv, music, movies, sexual, drugs, crime & violence – We have all this because it is our nature to rebel against our creator God and the gospel of Christ...for Satan blinds them – II Cor. 4:3-4)

3. That sinful nature is still with us after we are saved (Rom. 6:12-22), but we have the Holy Spirit (John 16:13) to help us

C. THERE IS A COMING JUDGMENT BY GOD AGAINST SIN (God is a holy God who hates sin and will have no part of it)

1. God planned it all and makes no mistakes (Rom. 9:16-23 – He knows who will and won't trust Christ as Savior)
2. God will laugh at the wicked (Psalm 2:4-9; 59:8; 37:12-13; Prov 1:22-33)
3. He is angry with the wicked everyday (Psalm 7:11)
4. A Great White Throne Judgment is coming and those that rejected Christ as Savior from their sin will be cast into the Lake of Fire (Matt. 10:28; Rev. 20:11-15)

D. THERE IS A SAVIOR FROM SIN AND THAT SAVIOR WHO IS SINLESS (1 John 3:5,9; II Cor. 5:21) IS JESUS CHRIST ALONE (JOHN 14:6)

1. Jesus is the Savior from the Penalty of Sin (saved from Eternal death & Hell) (John 3:16-21, 1 John 2:1-2)
2. Jesus is the Savior from the Power of Sin (By the Holy Spirit – currently!) (we see this in Rom. 8:1-14)
3. Jesus is the Savior from the Presence of Sin (He promises a home in Heaven someday)
4. Jesus wants to save all from sin (II Pet. 3:9; Titus 2:11; 1 Tim. 4:10) and save them forever (John 3:15-16; 10:28-29)

E. LIVING AS A CHRISTIAN IN A WICKED WORLD (Separation from sin – Rom. 6:1-2, 6-7; II Cor. 5:17)

The Book of Psalms: A Treasure From God – (Part 9) – By: Craig G.

Psalms 19 – “The Works and Words of God”

Vs. 1 – The beauty of God’s creation is clearly seen all around us. Praise the Great Creator today!

Vs. 1-6 – The omnipresence of the Lord and His power over all the heavens and earth.

Vs. 7-11 – Speaks of the nature, value and benefits of God’s word, character and will.

Vs. 7 – We come to know Christ through the preaching of the word. It restores the believer and we get wisdom from it.

Vs. 8 – His statutes are truths concerning righteous living that are a joy to the godly.

His commandments, principles, precepts are a guiding light for the faithful who seek His way.

Vs. 9 – The fear of the Lord is an act of God’s grace that gives us the right response of obedience and faith to who God is and what He can and will do; which bring freedom from a life of sin and shame.

Vs. 10 – His word is more precious than the finest gold! It is to be desired more than our necessary food and is sweetness to the soul.

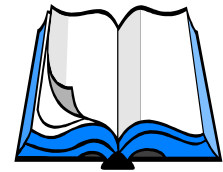
Vs. 11 - The Bible warns us of the danger of sin and how it breaks fellowship with God for a believer. There is great reward in keeping and obeying His word.

Vs. 12 – Endeavor to love

and serve Him with all your heart (Deut. 6:5). At times, you will fail and fall short of God’s will without knowing, so you need to seek His forgiveness for those hidden faults and errors. The heart is desperately wicked, who can know it? We are simply sinners saved by grace.

Vs. 13 – Presumptuous or willful sins can and do happen and are very dangerous. They break our fellowship with Him if not confessed and forsaken. They also affect our testimony and walk with Him. Again, we are sinners saved by grace.

Vs. 14 – The Lord is our Rock, our Strength, and our Redeemer. Therefore, we should be constantly seeking Him and asking Him in prayer to keep our heart and mind close to Him. Let the mind of Christ be in us. We should desire to please Him daily and be acceptable in His sight.

Wisdom from Proverbs – (Part 7) – By: Craig G.

Proverbs 8

Vs. 1-4, 12, 14-16 - The cry of, vastness and wideness of wisdom. Godly wisdom is very powerful and what we must have as believers. We can not be both worldly and godly wise. (1 Cor. 1 & 2)

Vs. 5 – The simple and the fool can know wisdom if they seek it with all their heart.

Vs. 6 – Godly wisdom needs to be applied in our lives. It helps us speak right things and excellent things.

Vs. 7-8 – Godly wisdom helps us speak truth and makes us hate speaking or hearing wicked speech.

Vs. 9 – God’s word is plain and simple to those who are wise and right to those who find knowledge from it.

Vs. 10,19 – Instruction in the word is better than silver and knowledge of it is better than the finest gold.

Vs. 11 – Godly wisdom is worth more than rubies, gold, even all the valuable things in earth!

Vs. 13 – This is the biblical definition of “The fear of the Lord”. Do you and I hate these things?

Vs. 17 – Diligently seek godly wisdom early and often. It will be found. It is a display of love.

Vs. 18-21 – The wealth, riches, fruit, and clear path seen from godly wisdom displayed in the believer’s life.

Vs. 22-31 – The deep, intimate, passionate love of God for His children, and His knowledge of us from the creation of the earth and mankind! These verses also expound and clearly teach that God is the Great Creator and we are to praise and worship the Creator, not the creation! Look at all that He hath made (clouds, fields, sea, ocean, etc.)!

Vs. 30-31 – The joy of a close walk with the Lord as we live a godly wise life in faith and obedience.

Vs. 32-33 – God’s children need to hearken to Him, keep His ways, hear instruction, be wise and not disdain teaching and preaching of the word. Have a hunger for the truth of God’s word to learn it, live it and love it.

Hebrews 4:12

“For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any two edged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discernor of the thoughts and intents of the heart.”

Vs. 34-35 – Blessing, life, and favour of the Lord come from being and living godly wise.

Vs. 36 – Not being godly wise is sin and wrongs our souls. We love death if we despise godly wisdom!
