“THE BOOK OF PSALMS: A TREASURE FROM GOD” — Part 5

Psalm 9 - “The Millennial Psalm”

1. Praise God with all your heart by doing His will - vs. 1
2. Be glad and rejoice in God. Praise His name in song. - vs. 2
3. God will protect you from your enemies - vs. 3-4
4. God's plan for the lost - vs. 5-8 (judgment)

5. God is our refuge in times of trouble (the oppressed if they will trust in Him) - vs. 9-10
6. Praise God and tell others of His greatness - vs. 11
7. He maketh inquisition for blood - vs. 12 (Gen. 9:5-6) and hears our cry
8. Cast your care upon the Lord. He can lift you up - vs. 13
9. Rejoice in your salvation -

vs. 14 (Ps. 13:15, 20:5, 35:9)

10. The sin of the wicked will find them out - vs. 15 (Num. 32:23)

11. Those that reject God will be cast into hell - vs. 16-17

12. We all are “but men” and absolutely nothing without God - vs. 18-19

Wisdom From Proverbs - (Part 3) - By: Craig G.

Proverbs 4

- 1. Children should listen, be attentive to their parents, and desire to grow in understanding as should a child of God their heavenly Father - vs. 1
- 2. God's word is good doctrine. Forsake it not. - vs. 2
- 3. One finds wisdom from God & parents. Obey them and desire to please God and family. - vs. 3-4
- 4. Forget not sound wisdom and seek after it. - vs. 5
- 5. Forake not sound wisdom for it shall preserve thee. In fact, Love it! - vs. 6
- 6. Wisdom is principal. We can't serve God without wisdom. - vs. 7
- 7. Hungering for and living wisely brings success in our walk with the Lord - vs. 8-9
- 8. Walking wisely increases days of living - vs. 10
- 9. Have you been taught in

the way of wisdom and led in right paths? - vs. 11

10. When we walk wisely our steps will not be hindered and we will not stumble beyond where God wants us to be. - vs. 12

11. Take firm hold of God's word. Hunger for it, love it, live it! God's word gives and brings life! - vs. 13

12. If we don't walk wisely, we have entered the path of the wicked and the ways of evil men! - vs. 14

13. Avoid the path of the wicked no matter the cost - vs. 15

14. The wicked do not have true rest. They do not know God at all and hunger for wickedness - vs. 16-17

16. The path of those who walk wisely is made clear by the Lord and He enlightens it even brighter every day as we walk with Him as believers - vs. 18

17. The path of the wicked is always darkness and they

stumble and grope as they are helplessly lost in their sin and totally separated from God! - vs. 19

18. Attend and listen to God's word. It is life! Do not let them depart from you ever! Hide it in your heart! - vs. 20-22a

19. God's word is health to the flesh. - vs. 22b

20. Keep your heart with all dilligence. Guard your heart. Glow your heart, and glue it to the Lord by giving your heart/your all to and for God. - vs. 23

21. Keep deceit and ungodly talk far from your heart and lips - vs. 24

22. Turn your eyes upon Jesus and in the Bible. Don't look back into the world of sin - vs. 25

23. Consider your ways. Seek God in all choices. Move only forward through eyes of faith - vs. 26-27
