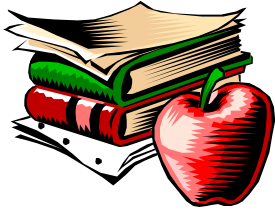

Meditate on The Word (Psalm 1:2; Psalm 119:148)

Good Bye Old World (By: Pastor David Smith) – 1 John 2

The following is based on a recent Wed. evening Bible study at Community Baptist Church of Quakertown, PA by Pastor David Smith.

According to the Word of God, it is impossible to love God and love the world and the things of the world at the same time. Yet, so many of us carry on a secret love affair with worldliness. We can try hard to get someone to stop loving and living for this world but the fact is, until we experience the joy of a deep love for God, worldliness will be a problem in our life. Jesus did not pray for God to take us out of this world but that He would take the world out of us. We live in this world but we must not let the world live in us.

FOUR KEYS TO OVERCOMING WORLDLINESS IN YOUR LIFE:

1. COMPREHEND THE ENEMY OF THE WORLD. – 2:15

- Because of its Leader (Satan – leader of the world’s system)

- Because of its **Lusts** (Gal. 1:4, 1 John 5:19, II Pet. 2:7)

- Because of its **Lies** (“You need this” – i.e. TV ads)

2. COMPREHEND THE **EMPTINESS** OF THE WORLD – 2:16

- It may take great **Loss** to change our minds.

“worldlings make gold their God, saints make God their gold.” (Matthew Henry)

- It may take a fresh **Look** to change our vision. (Long for Christ! Desire Christ 1st and most!)

“To many of us wander in the wilderness, longing for garlic, instead of grace, melons instead of manna.” (Havner)

- It will take a greater **Love** to change our heart. (1 John 2:28)

“Conformity to the world can be overcome by nothing but conformity to Jesus Christ.”

3. COMPREHEND THE **END** of the world – 2:17

“If you are wise, let the world pass, lest you pass away with the world.”

- Headed for the **Waste Heap** (Wood, hay and stubble) (the world preeminent and NOT Christ.)

- Headed for the **Burn Pile** (1 Pet. 3:10) (Temporary material things)

- Headed away from God’s **Will**

4. COMPREHEND THE **ETERNITY** OF THE WORLD TO **COME**. – 2:17

- I’ll be forever **Rich** (Matt. 6) (1 Tim. 6)

- I’ll be forever **Rewarded** (Give up the world) (Luke 18)

- I’ll be forever **Received** (In the right place, because of a right choice with a righteous God.)

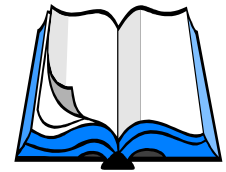

## Emotions in the Bible (Part 4) (By: Craig G.)

There are many verses and passages in the Bible that relate to emotions and feelings of man and our Lord Himself in trials, suffering, affliction, and of course peace and joy. The following is an ongoing study of passages that have convicted, comforted, edified, encouraged or blessed me through hearing messages, devotions and studies over the years. I hope this is a blessing and help to you and I, and that the Lord may be honored and glorified in this series of studies on emotions in the Bible. Each issue, Lord willing, will have a verse or passage in the Bible covered. I am excited and privileged to do this. Praise God! I intend to break each passage down into the following: **Passage, Emotion(s), Cause, Effect, What does the passage say?, What does the passage say to you and I?, What should you and I do about it?, How do you and I stay accountable?**



### II Timothy 3:16-17

*“All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works.”*

### Hebrews 4:12

*“For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any two edged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.”*

**Passage:** Psalm 128:1-2– *“Blessed is every one that feareth the LORD; that walketh in His ways. For thou shalt eat the labour of thine hands: happy shalt thou be, and it shall be well with thee.”*

**Emotion(s):** Fear (feareth)-Reverential Awe of God, Happiness

**Cause:** Fearing the Lord, Walking in His ways

**Effect:** Blessing for every one that feareth the LORD, Enjoyment of the labour of our hands, happiness and wellness

**What does the passage say?** This passage says a lot! It says that EVERY ONE that feareth (*has a reverential awe and respect of who and what God is and what He can and will do*) the Lord and walks in His ways and not the ways of the world is blessed (happy)! It says we will eat the labour of thine hands. I believe we will be given wisdom and knowledge by the Lord to be a good steward of our time, talent and treasure. It says we will be happy and it will be well. We will have peace that passes all understanding whether we are in the valley of trials or on the mountaintop. Those whose heart and mind are stayed upon Him will have peace.

**What does the passage say to you and I?** Ask yourself daily and often; am I walking in His ways? Am I fearing the Lord? Am I a faithful steward of my time, my talent and my finances? Is my happiness and joy real? Is it of the Lord or just worldly temporary joy? Is it well with your soul? Believer, prayerfully seek the Lord and consider these questions and how they relate to your daily walk with the Lord.

**What should you and I do about it?** Fear Him and strive to walk in His ways by meditating in His word daily, praying, praising, witnessing and being faithful to your local church. Strive to be a faithful steward giving God all your time, talent and treasure for it is all His to begin with. Realize that true joy, happiness and peace can only be in and of Christ.

**How do you and I stay accountable?** Stay looking in the word and looking up to God in prayer. Seek out counsel from a pastor, family member or friend when you struggle with this passage.
