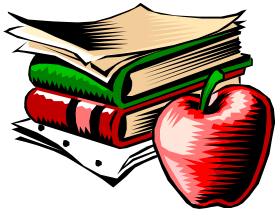

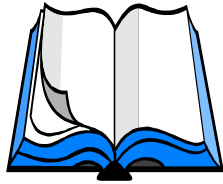
Proverbs 5

1. Pay attention to wisdom from God's word and incline your ears to understand it. – vs. 1
2. Preserve discretion and let your lips speak the knowledge of His word – vs. 2
3. Be cautious of immorality (i.e. a strange woman) and avoid the lips of the wicked – vs. 3-6
4. Keep far from wicked speech, thoughts and all types of wickedness – vs. 7-8
5. The results of not keeping our lips and guarding our hearts

and lusts – vs. 9-11

6. Never despise instruction and reproof – vs. 12
7. You will be very guilty of despising instruction and reproof – vs. 12-13
8. Total ruin will come as a result – vs. 14, 22-23
9. Be faithful to your spouse. Never lust after any other – vs. 15-17, 20
10. Cherish and enjoy the love and relationship with your spouse that God has blessed you with – vs. 18-19
11. Nothing is hid from God. He knows are

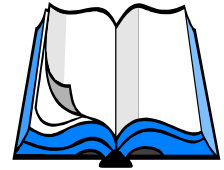
